In the interest of our Kids & Chrome auction donors, as well as to guarantee a diverse offering of auction items that will most likely heighten the interest of our Kids & Chrome event attendees, the following standards have been established. These standards are intended to provide guidance to our donors as they consider their prospective auction donation to ensure their donation raises top auction dollars.

STANDARDS:

- Donation package(s) with a minimum retail value of \$150.00 are preferred
- Donation should be new and in premium condition
- Donation should be unique, original, special edition or “sought after” item
- Donation of artwork should be original or limited editions (signed or numbered preferred)

HELPFUL HINTS TO MAKE YOUR DONATION SUCCESSFUL:

- Donation should be exclusive or distinct as many “off the shelf” items do not do well
- Donations that are “Native of South Dakota” (Native American artifacts, buffalo or pheasant hunts, Black Hills Gold pieces, Sturgis collectibles, etc.) do well
- Donations for Women (designer name jewelry, purses, sunglasses, etc. with “bling”) do well
- Donations for Men (hunting or fishing trips, rifles, knives, etc.) do well
- Donations such as one of a kind or limited editions do well
- Donations with a destination/trip (Bahamas cruise, NASCAR race with suite passes, etc.) do well
- Donations that can be autographed or signed by celebrities and industry legends (guitars, helmets, leather jackets, etc.) do well

INFORMATION TO DONOR:

- In order to avoid duplication of items and decrease risk for items that historically have not sold well, all donations are subject to approval of the Kids & Chrome Auction Committee
- All accepted donations must be accompanied with an information piece or brochure of the item or a very specific definition of the item and a good quality digital image to be displayed on Kids & Chrome website
- All donations must be submitted, approved and received by June 15th, 2009
- Donations that are not successfully sold at the Kids & Chrome event auction may be listed on eBay through a local partnership with iSOLDIt, an eBay registered trading assistant, to benefit Kids & Chrome Foundation, Inc.
- Acknowledgements will be provided to auction donors to document charitable contributions for tax purposes
